Lab Fee:

The Photography & Videography Program collects a lab fee to provide incoming students with the supplies they require to complete assigned projects, skills and many self-directed endeavors. This fee is an estimate of what the average student consumes during the school year. It will be collected by the Admissions Department along with tuition. Additional Materials and Supplies:

A small amount of supplies will still be required beyond what the lab fee provides. These items should be acquired prior to the start of classes in September. Please refer to the list below for more information and do not hesitate to contact the program instructor directly if you have any questions. All items are commonly available at your local hardware and office supply stores.

- Notebook
- Pens and pencils (a selection of each, good quality)
- Waterproof markers (Sharpies), black and red (one each, fine point)
- Large utility "box cutter" type knife with "snap-off" retractable blades
- Wide masking tape (1 roll)
- Wide duct tape (1 roll)
- Combination Lock(s) (1 or 2 as required)
- Portable hard drive (2-4 TB)

Note: Hard drive can be one you already own but if so, it must be empty and may need to be formatted for use with Macintosh operating systems (or both Mac and PC).

Portfolio Case:

You will require a portfolio case before the end of the first semester, but please do not make this purchase prior to starting the program as the instructor will discuss various options with you once classes have begun. For now, please set aside approximately \$200 for this purchase.

Only the editions specified above will be accepted.

Students Coming from Outside the Province/Country

Camera Requirements:

You are required to enter the program with a DSLR or mirrorless camera system. In addition to the "normal zoom" lens that usually comes with these cameras, a "telephoto zoom" lens is also recommended (e.g., 55-200mm, 70-200mm). Approval is required from the program instructor in order to deviate from the recommendations listed below.

Even though the market now includes several new brands, especially in the mirrorless category, Canon is still an ideal option as we currently stock a wide range of lenses, flashes and other accessories compatible with this system.
