

## Students currently living outside of Canada

Below you will find two **very important** website links that we would suggest you revisit as often as you can as some of these restrictions may change daily, weekly, or monthly. If you are not eligible to enter Canada prior to your program start date, please inform us as soon as possible. You are responsible for ensuring that you are eligible to enter Canada prior to departing your home country, so please do not travel to Canada unless you are certain that you meet all requirements outlined by the Government of Canada.

- This link defines which international students are eligible to enter Canada. If you are an international student who has a valid study permit, or were approved for a study permit on or before **March 18, 2020**, you are exempt from the travel restrictions.

If you are eligible to enter Canada, you will also have to follow the following steps:

1. Contact Julia at [julia@hollandcollege.com](mailto:julia@hollandcollege.com) to get instructions on completing the required Holland College Pre-Travel Approval form.

Once you complete this form you will receive (within 5 business days) a "Letter of Permission to Attend" (PTA), you will be **REQUIRED** to provide a copy of this letter upon entry in to the province and without it you will be rejected entry by the Government of PEI.

2. You **MUST** also complete the Government of Prince Edward Island's Pre-Travel Approval form

\*The Government of PEI is in the process of arranging your 14 day self-isolation plan including accommodations, transportation, food, security, internet/wi-fi. When arriving in Prince Edward Island (either by vehicle or by air) you will be directed to go immediately to the pre-planned self-isolation location; this detailed information will be provided to you in the coming weeks. Only those who complete the Holland College online Pre-Travel Approval form will receive this information.

For those whose program starts during the first week of September, it is expected that you will arrive in PEI between August 16, 2020 and September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. For those students who have a program with a later “Blended/Face to Face” start date, we are advising that you arrive 14 days prior.

\*\*Failure to follow the Provincial and Federal Government guidelines will result in you not being able to arrive in PEI or Canada and may cause the inability to attend Holland College classes this fall.
