1. To provide a tobacco and smoke free work and study environment for faculty, staff, students and visitors Holland College will not permit the use or sale of any tobacco product, or the smoking of any products on College-owned or leased properties.
2. This Policy applies to all College buildings, facilities, and grounds including, but not limited to, offices, open office areas, laboratories, workshops, classrooms, libraries, residences, sporting facilities, stairwells, hallways, entrances, lobbies, reception areas, elevators, lounges, lunchrooms, cafeterias, washrooms, parking lots, College-owned or leased or rented vehicles, etc.
3. This Policy applies to all College faculty, staff, students, and visitors. Visitors include, but are not limited to, members of the general public, guests, contractors and suppliers, and their employees.
4. This Policy applies to all external organizations using or contemplating use of College buildings and facilities.
5. The President is authorized to establish Regulations, Guidelines and Procedures that may be necessary in order to implement and enforce this Policy.
